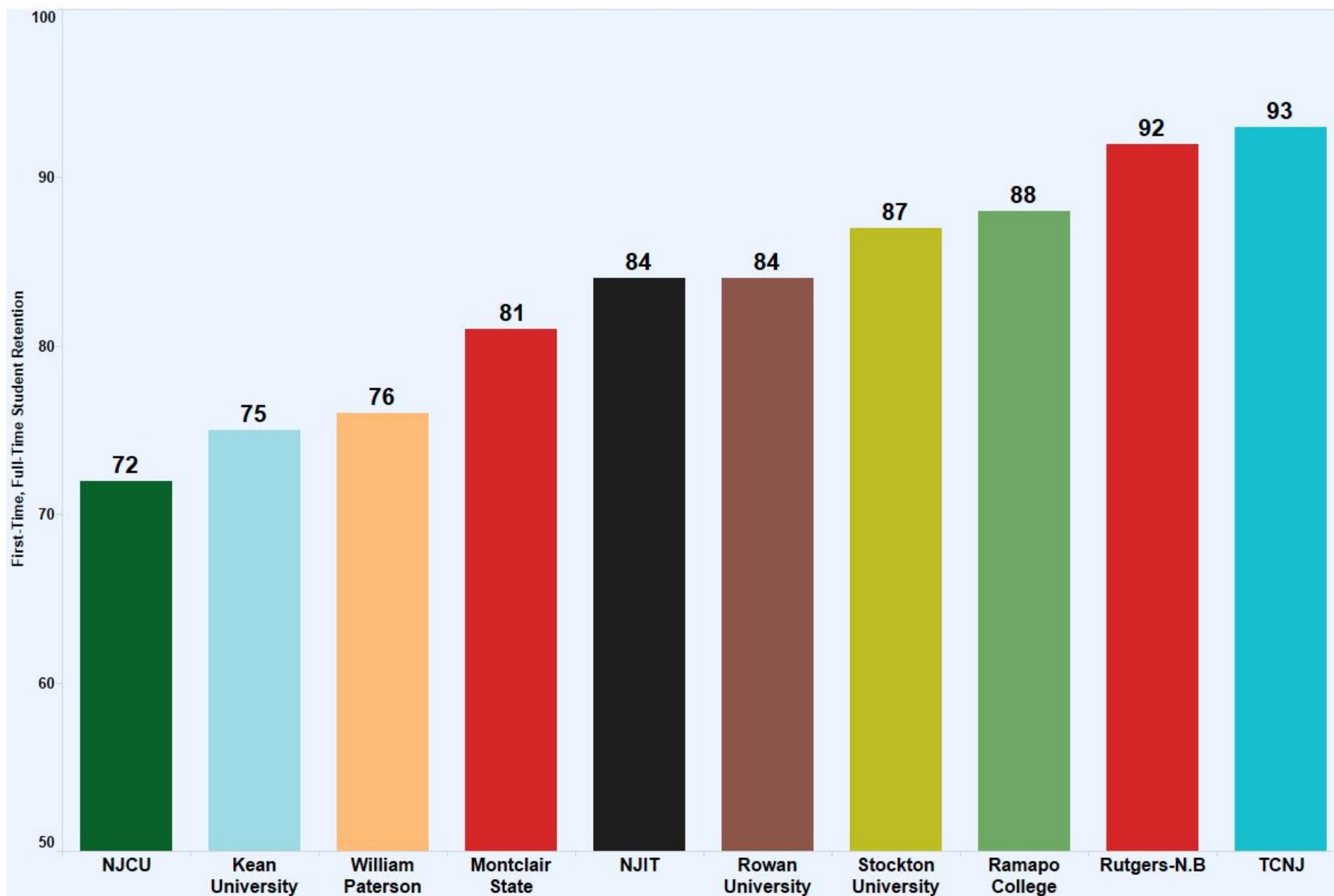


Section I: Student Retention and Graduation Rates by Select Categories



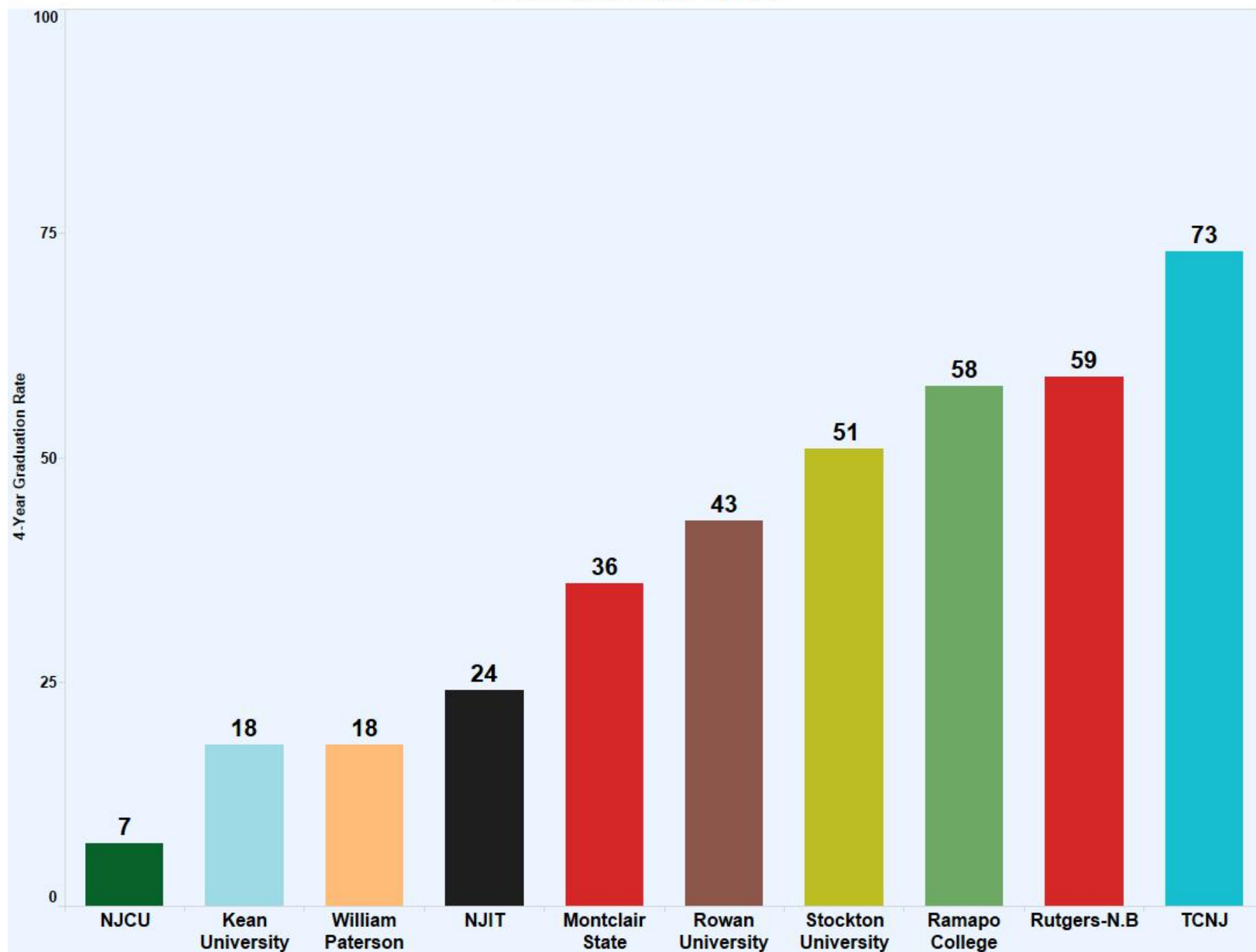
First-Time, Full-Time Student Retention Rate (2013-2014)

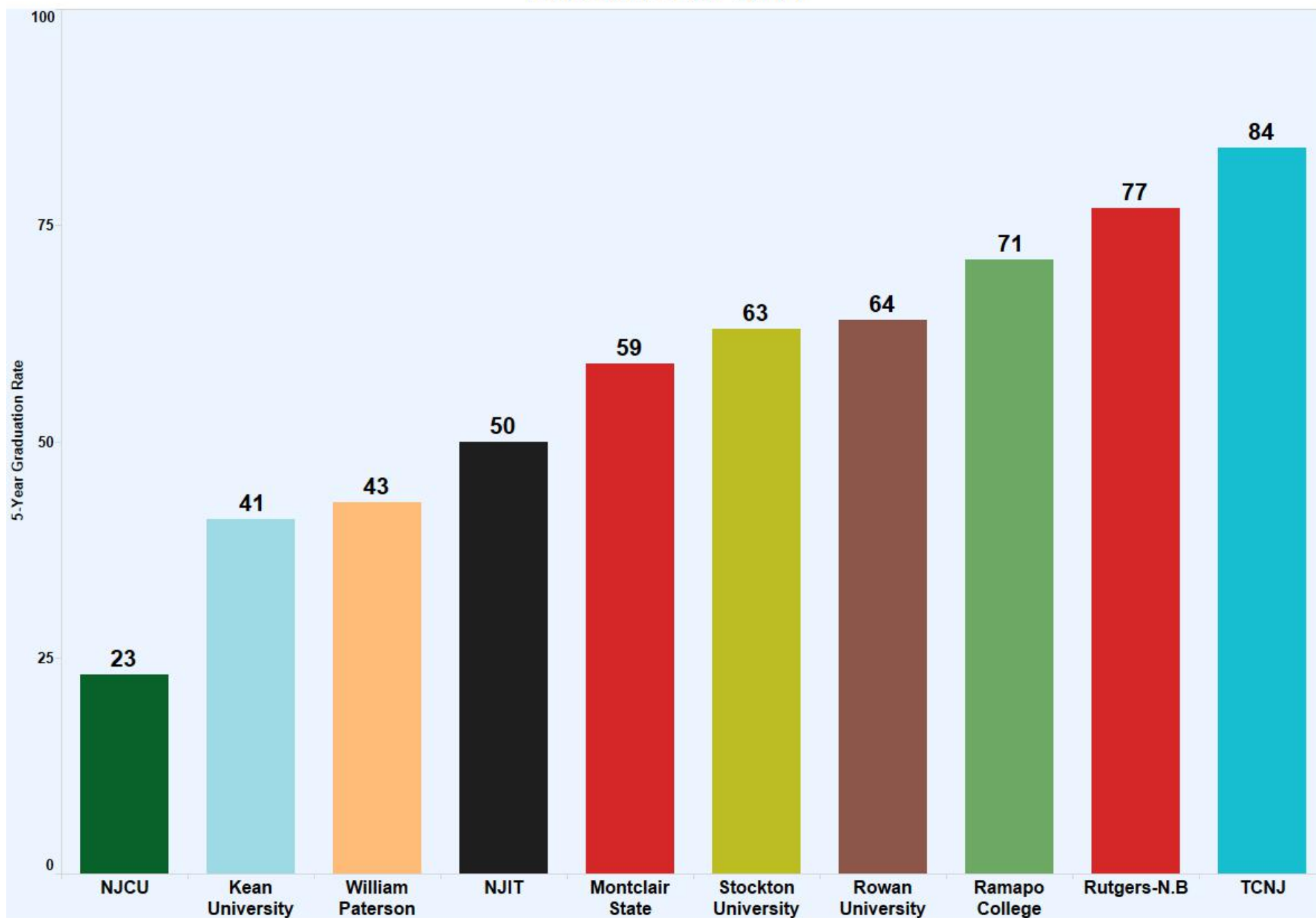
NJ Public Colleges 4 Year Grad Rate (2008 Cohort)

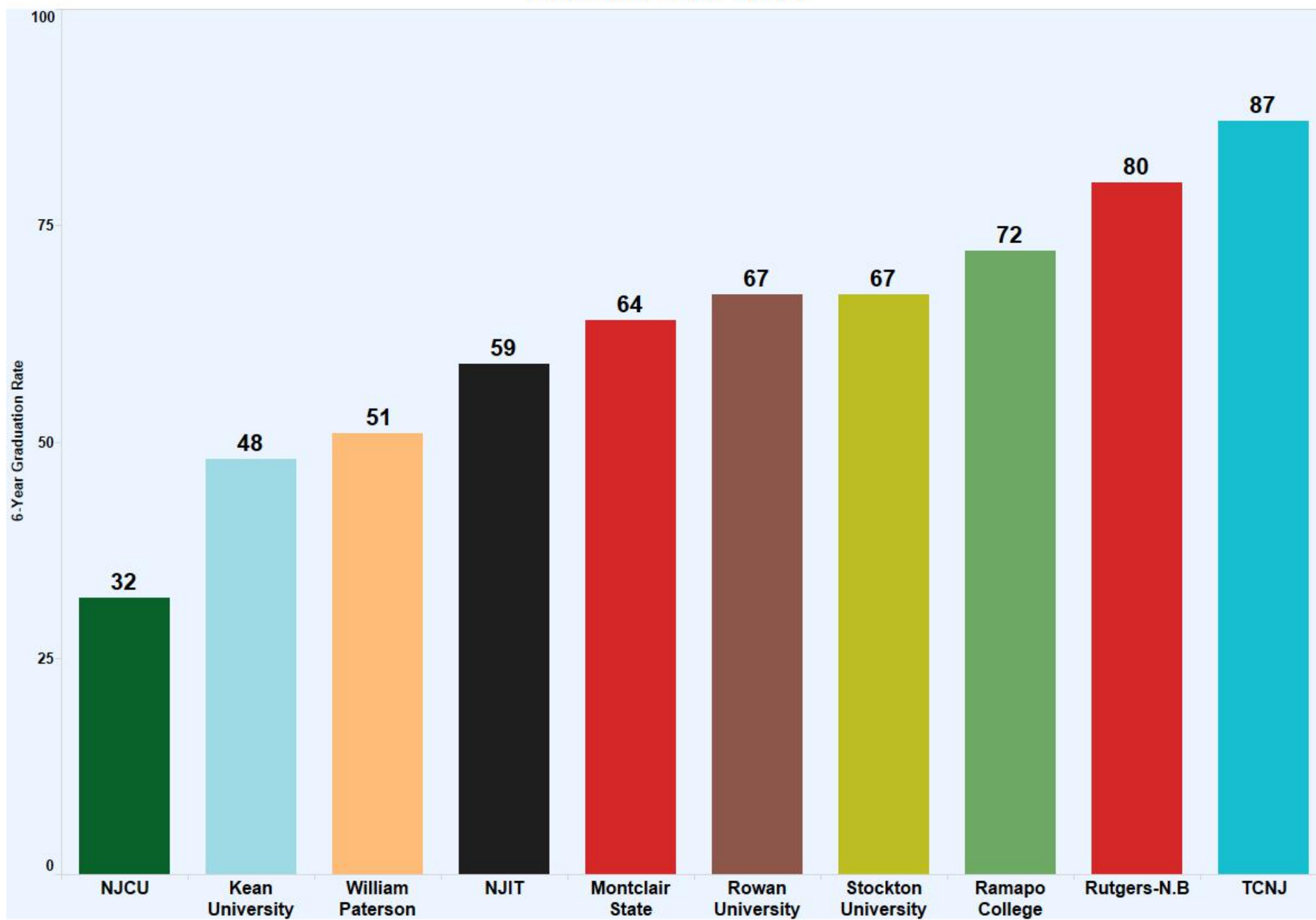
NJ Public Colleges 5 Year Grad Rate (2008 Cohort)

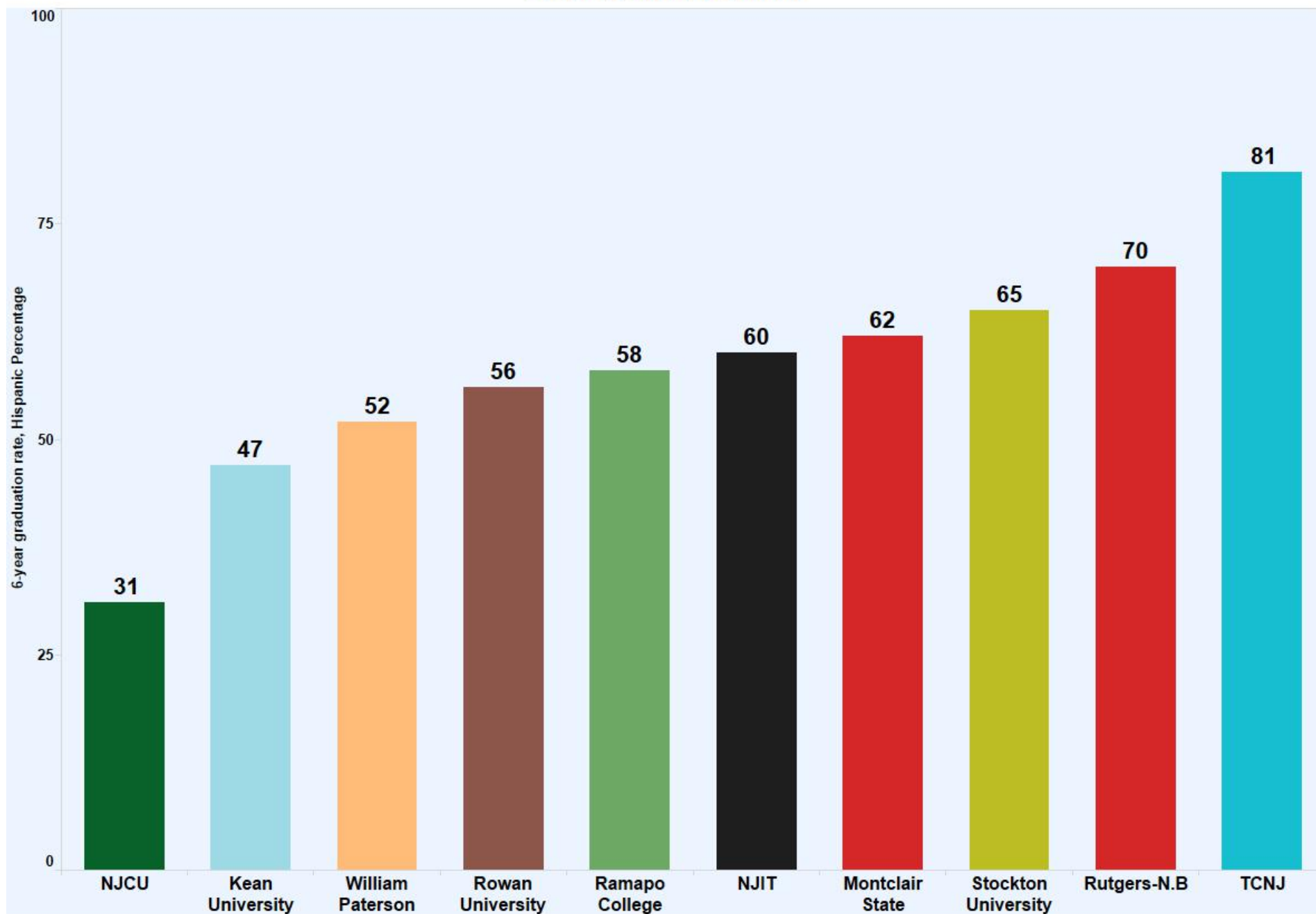
NJ Public Colleges 6 Year Graduation Rate (2008 Cohort)

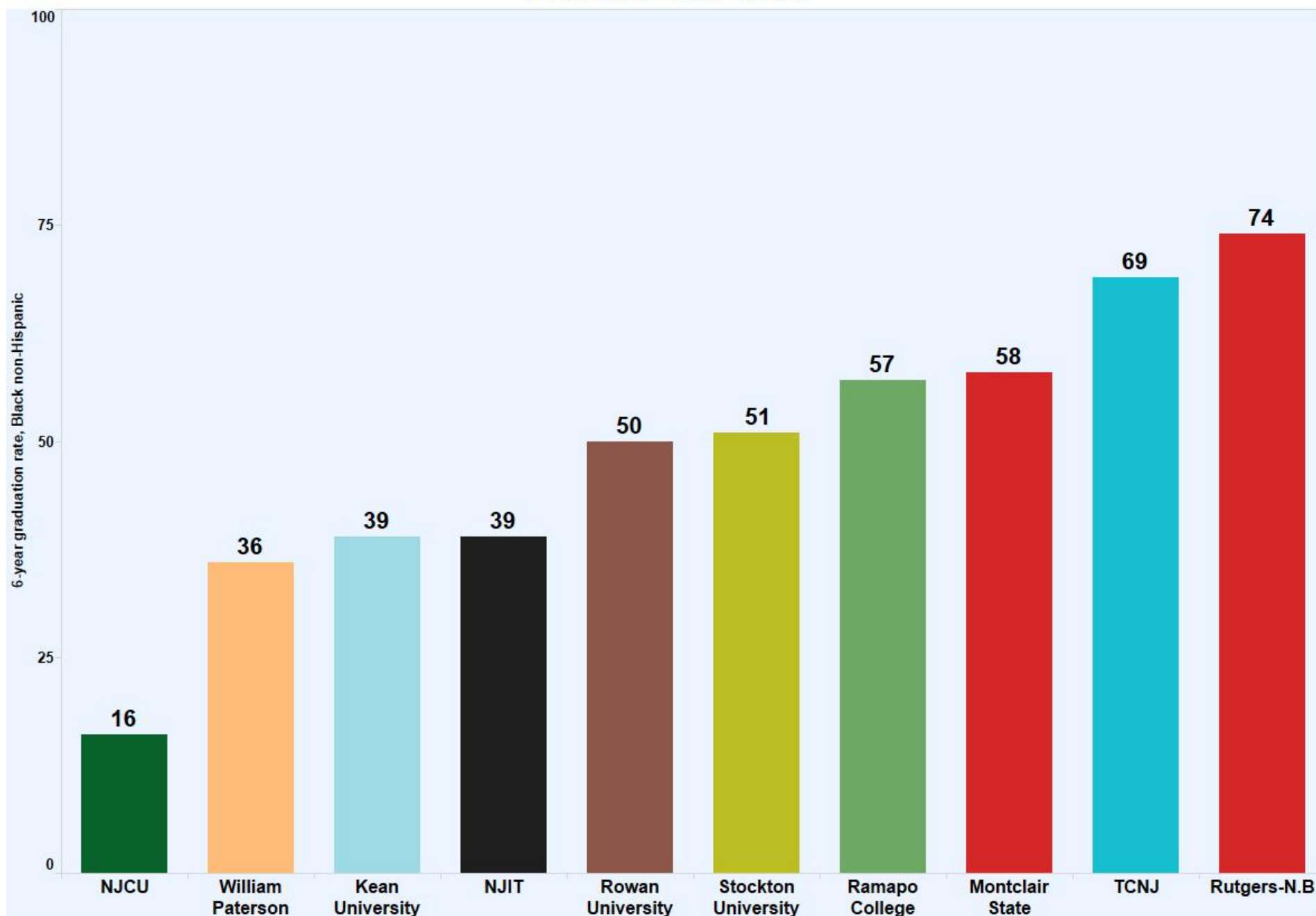
6-Year Graduation Rate, Latinos (2008 Cohort)

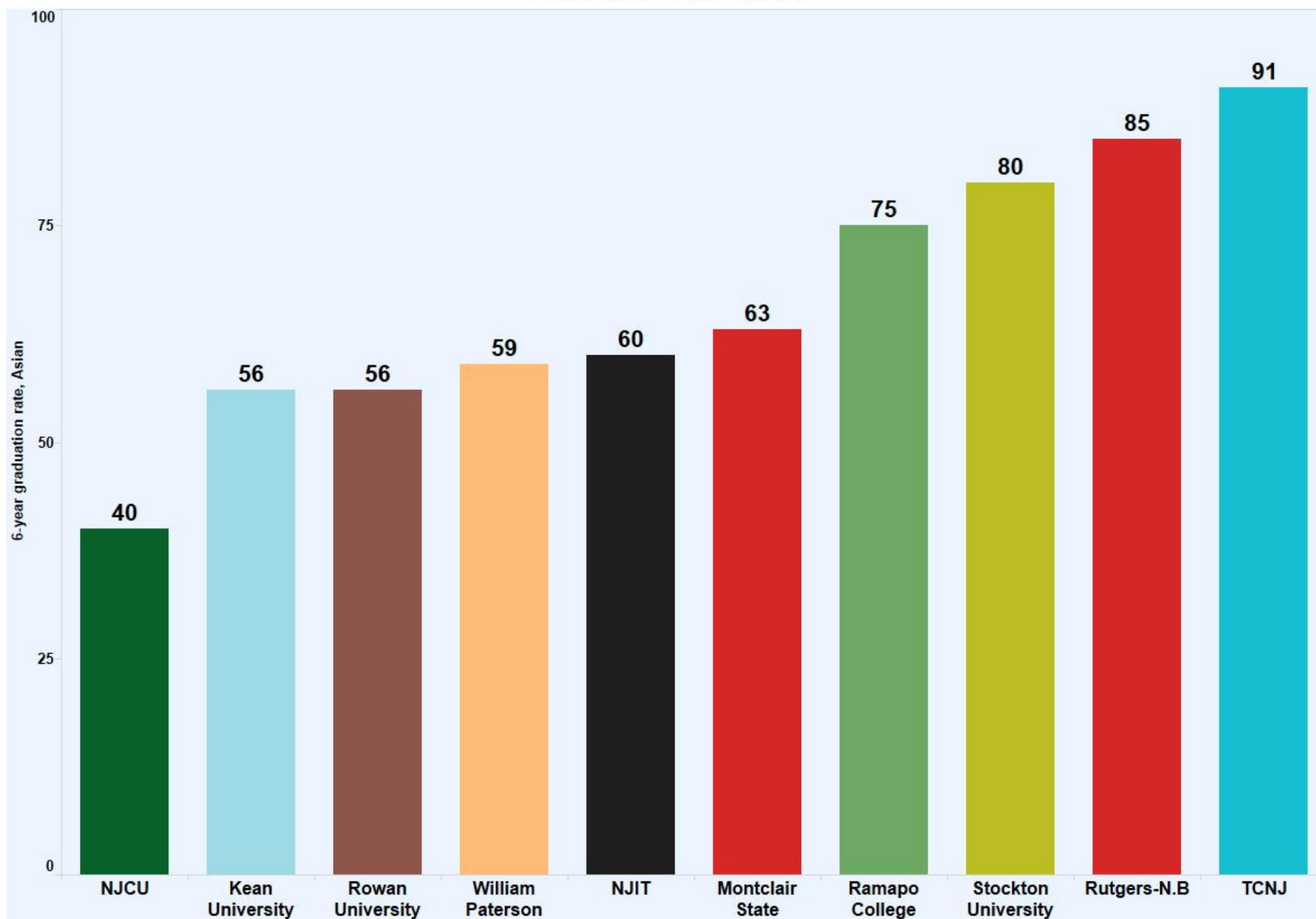
6-Year Graduation Rate, African American (2008 Cohort)

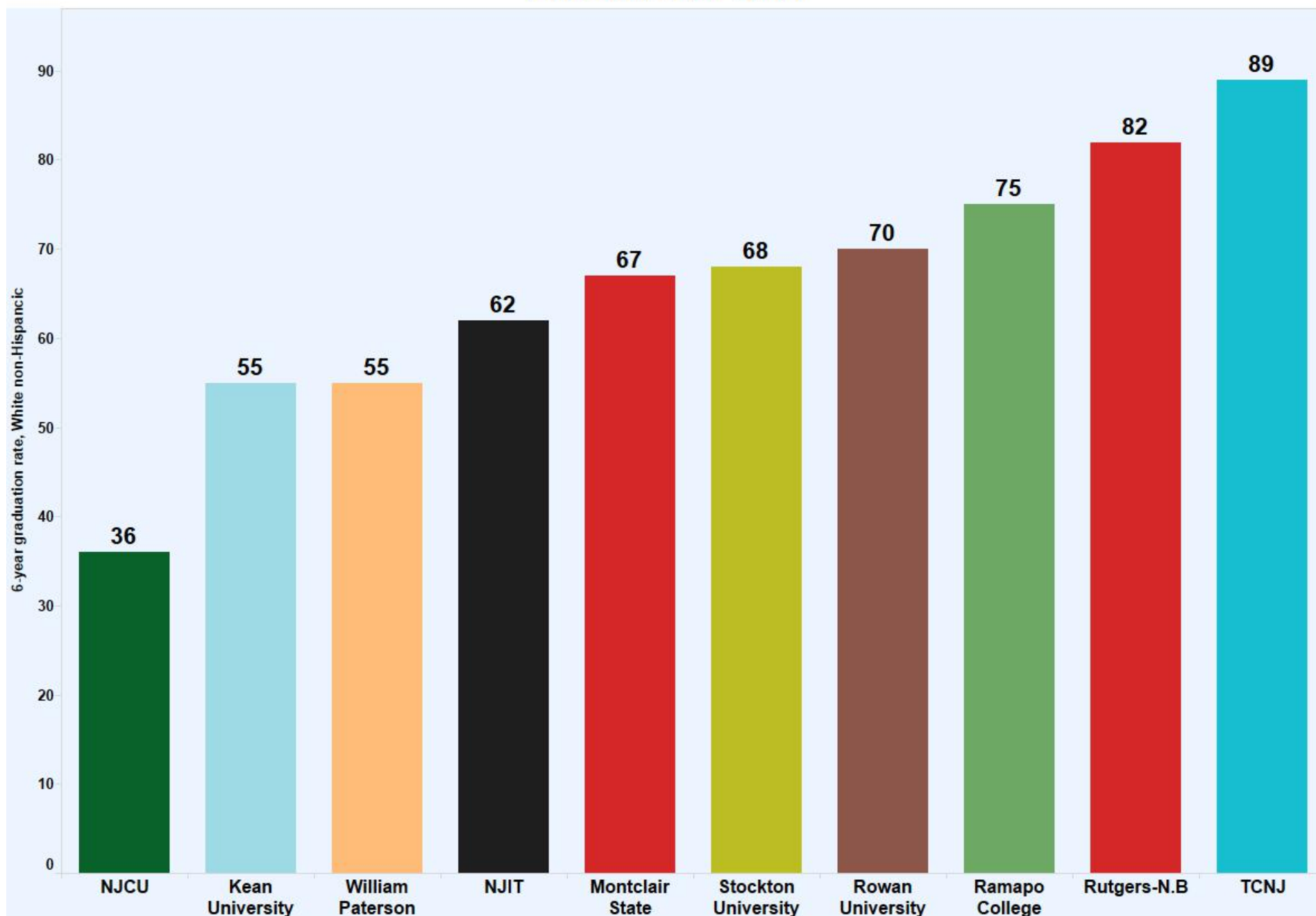
6-Year Graduation Rate, Asian (2008 Cohort)

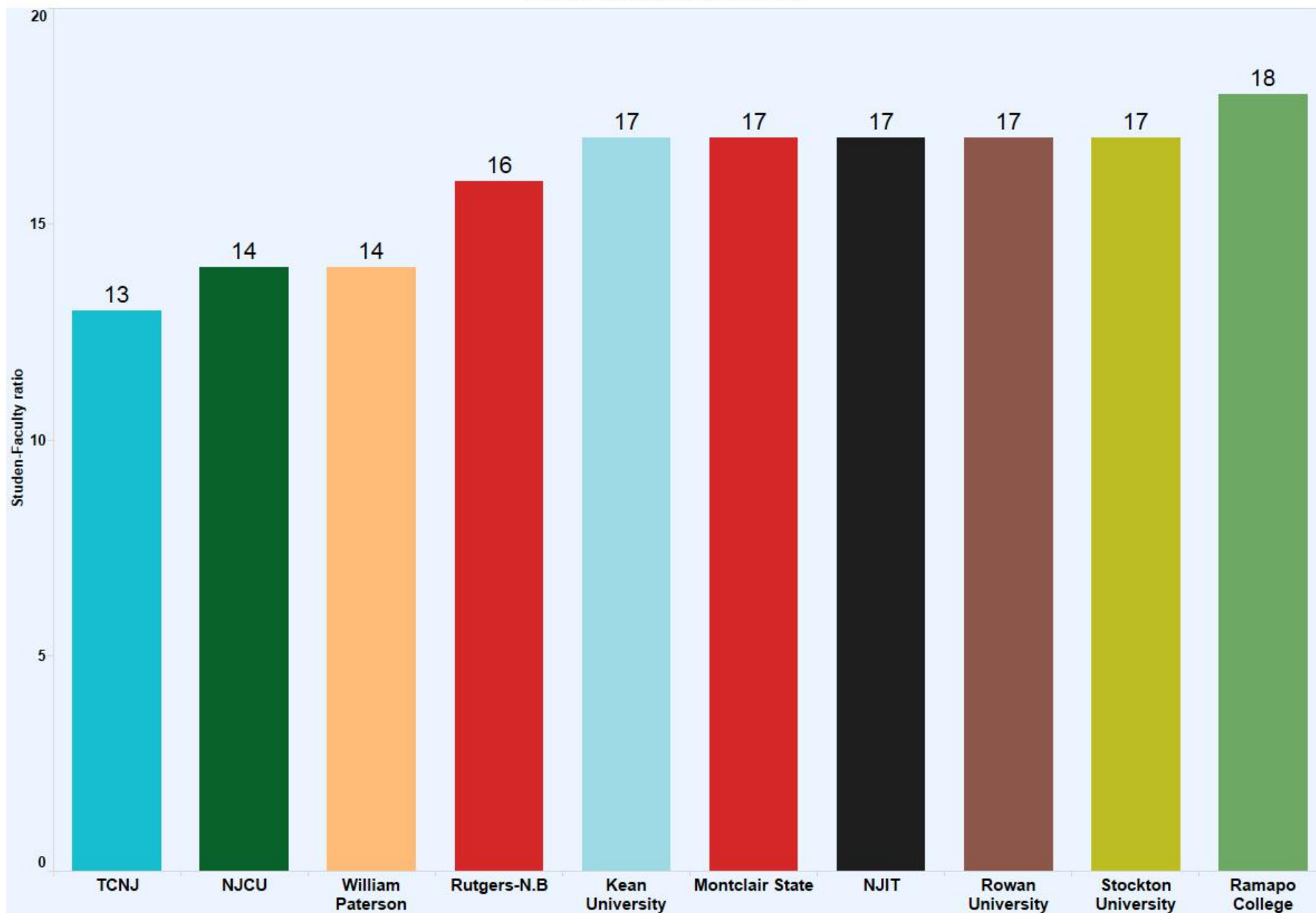

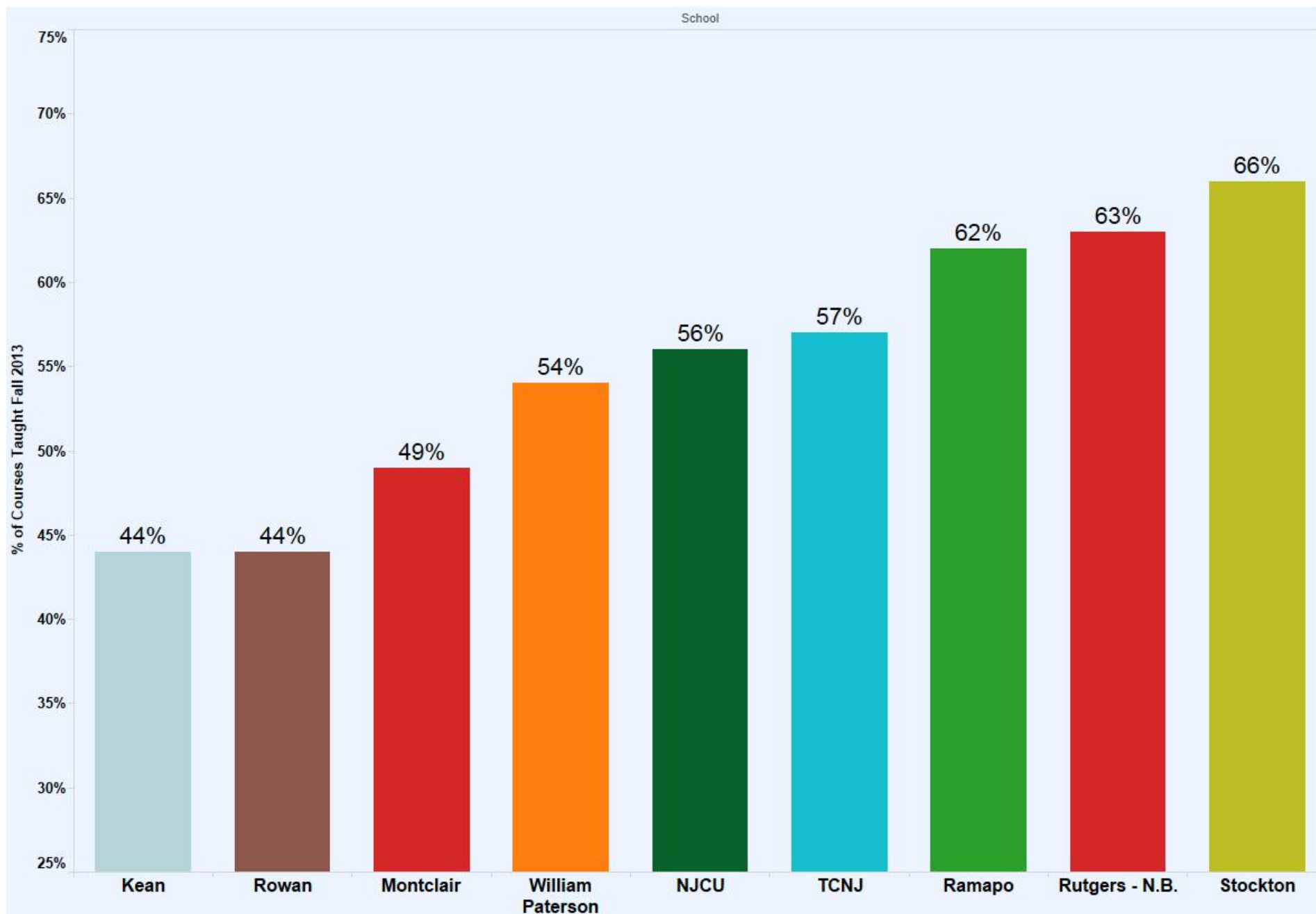
Student-Faculty Ratio (2014)
